Following the Grenfell Fire investigation into residential building safety management led by Dame Judith Hackitt, there will be new requirements to adopt a system safety perspective of Higher Risk Buildings (HRBs) to better understand the risks posed to residents.



April 2022

Building Safety Act: All "higher-risk residential buildings" will need a safety case in coming years.

October 2023

All existing higher-risk buildings must be registered with the regulator.

April 2024

The Building Safety Regulator will be able to call in buildings for assessment - requesting safety case reports for inspection.

Safety Case Requirements



Safety case reports are the main way that the Joint Competent Authority (JCA) will hold landlords to account for identifying, mitigating and managing the hazards and risks in their buildings. Landlords will be required to present safety case reports to the JCA at regular intervals to demonstrate that risks are being managed effectively.
